More news about some things we have revived at Prince George and finally our most popular coupon deal on Museum Glass.

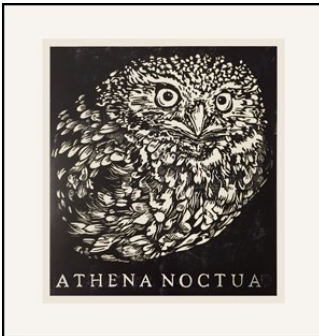

Paula Goodman Koz: The Art of Woodblock Printing

Opening June 20, 2019 at 5pm will be our next show, **“Paula Goodman Koz: *The Art of Woodblock Printing*”** a display of the varied prints of this very talented artist. Paula has worked in woodblock printing for forty years and we will show some of her work over the years.

Original prints are created by using various matrixes to create the image on the paper where the image is to be viewed. These matrixes include etched copper plates, stone blocks, engraved metal plates, silk screen stencils, or carved wood, or linoleum blocks. Woodblock prints are created by cutting a design into blocks of wood leaving the area to be printed above the rest of the block creating a relief image of the print to be made. Woodblock (or woodcut) prints have been around since the third century

BC in China and became more familiar to the western world in the sixteenth century when Albrecht Durer used the medium to create his wonderful prints such as “The Four Horsemen”. Paula Koz creates her woodblock prints in the same manner by cutting the design into the wood blocks using a separate block for each of the colors in the finished print. A lot of work to make the enigmatic work of art we enjoy.
